MRJ Travels to Arizona for High Altitude Testing

MRJ's Flight Test Aircraft 4 (FTA-4) performed high altitude flight testing at Flagstaff Pulliam Airport in Flagstaff, Arizona in mid-January. This was an important benchmark that gauged whether engines, auxiliary power and other important aircraft systems could perform well in thin, low density air.
